FEES AND GUIDELINES

FEES: A boarding fee is charged for every shift that your pet is present at the hospital starting on the day of admitting. Pets boarded together in the same kennel or cage will be charged at a reduced rate. Additional fees are charged if your pet needs medication or there special circumstances involved in boarding.

ADMIT/DISCHARGE TIMES: Boarding pets are admitted and discharged between 7 am and 6 pm. If you chose to admit or discharge your pet outside of these times there will be an additional charge of \$75.00 per pet. **CLIENT INITIAL:** _____

VACCINES: Pets that need vaccines to be boarded will be charged a consultation fee. **CLIENT INITIAL:** _____

PETS BOARDED TOGETHER: If you request that your pets are boarded together please let us know if they can be aggressive towards each other. Pets boarded together that display aggression or attack each other will be boarded separately and you will be charged accordingly.

If we cannot contact you or your emergency contacts or in the event an emergency occurs, you give permission for the doctors and staff at Arlington Animal Hospital, Inc. to provide whatever medical and/or surgical treatment is necessary for your pet and you agree to accept responsibility for all fees. You agree there is no guarantee of a favorable outcome and you will still be responsible for all fees. You agree to release Arlington Animal Hospital, Inc. and its doctors and staff of all liability associated with boarding and treatment of your pet.

EXAMINATIONS, FLEAS AND TICKS

We keep our hospital flea and tick free. All pets receive an intake technician examination and will be checked for fleas and ticks. If fleas and ticks are found they will be treated at your expense. Upon discharge all pets receive a discharge technician examination to verify that they are flea and tick free. If parasites are observed in your pet's stool while boarding your pet will be treated at your expense.

VACCINATIONS AND GENERAL HEALTH

For the safety all pets must be current with core vaccines within a one year period and pets must be in good general health. In lieu of vaccination your pet may have a vaccine titer panel that demonstrates adequate immunity current within a one year period. By signing this form you certify that your pet is in good general health and is not currently ill or under treatment for a contagious illness. For vaccination to provide maximum benefit, they must be administered no less than 2 weeks before boarding. Vaccinations administered at the time of boarding may provide partial but not maximum protection.

All boarded pets are fed high quality Eukanuba Low Residue dry food as it is gentle on the gastric system and less likely to cause gastric disturbances. If your pet is on a special diet or a different brand of pet food, please provide the food and it will be fed based upon your instructions at no additional charge. Bring your pet's food in a marked container with an adequate quantity for your pet's stay plus two extra days. If your pet(s) runs out of the food you have provided we will charge your account for a bag of pet food that is the closest equivalent to your pet's food. Please indicate your preference below.

MEDICATIONS

Please bring your pet's medications along with clear instructions as to how your pet is medicated. In the event you do not provide us with instructions, we will follow the instructions on the medication container or use our best judgment. If your pet runs out of medication we will fill a prescription, charge your account and administer it according to the previous medication's directions.

CLIENT ITEMS

It is best not to board your pet with personal items as they can become lost, destroyed or badly soiled and may need to be disposed of for sanitary reasons. If you leave items with us, including leashes and collars, we will try our best to protect these items but we cannot be responsible for these items as they may be destroyed, soiled or disposed of. You will not be refunded money to replace or repair these items.

STRESS RELATED ISSUES

All boarded pets, even fully vaccinated pets, placed in stressful situations may suffer decreased immunity and gastric changes. Vaccines do not protect against all disease. **All boarded pets become susceptible to sore throats, voice changes, canine cough, diarrhea, constipation, excessive grooming and shedding. We cannot be responsible for costs associated with these conditions if they arise during or after boarding and you agree not to hold us liable for any costs associated with these conditions.** We do not recommend boarding for extremely old, chronically ill or debilitated pets. These pets have a significantly higher risk of injury, progression of illness, debilitation and susceptibility to disease.

GROOMING SERVICES

You may request the following grooming services while your pet is here. Brushing/bathing services will be performed the day prior to discharge. If you wish to use a specific shampoo please provide the shampoo or we will select our regular hospital Aloe and Oatmeal cleansing shampoo.

BOARDING EXTENSIONS

Unforeseen events do occur. In the event that your pet cannot be picked up on the designated day, call us prior to the discharge day or as soon as reasonably possible to inform us of the delay and provide us with a new discharge day. Pets left for more than 5 days passed the discharge date without owner contact will be considered abandoned. Please take our business card with you as it contains contact information for the hospital.
